PE and School Sport Funding

Context

In April 2013 the Government announced new funding of £150 million for PE and Sport to be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision. This has been extended for a further period. Allocated Funding for Orchards is 2 x £4,287 each year. Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision. We at Orchards have a very strong tradition of high quality PE provision which is verified by our National Kitemark Awards at the highest level- Activemark Gold and School Games Gold

Our current provision includes:

Staffing

- Explicit leadership role with allowance for PE & Sport
- 2 x Specialist Teachers employed full time
- 1 x Apprentice working 3 days per week
- 20 members of staff are involved in running a weekly sports club
- External coaches utilized e.g. basketball, cricket etc

CPD

- CPD meetings for PE and Sport provided each year
- Clubs co-ordinated to ensure single equality and range of opportunity

Curriculum

- 2 hours high quality PE guaranteed each week
- Sports Leader programme well established in Year 6
- 20+ extra-curricular clubs provided including Extended Learning Opps toorching

Partnership

- Buy into Worthing Schools partnership
- Link with Chichester University and Worthing Sixth Form

Competition

- 3 tier competition for all in-school, inter school and county
- Fixtures exist for all year groups in all sports
- Run festivals for our own age range and feeder schools

Coaching

- Free swimming provided for all Year 5 pupils
- All clubs after and before school are free of charge for pupils

Equipment

- Minibus for fixtures and Extended Learning Opps
- Excursions to top level sporting venues e.g. Twickenham, Olympics, etc
- High quality equipment and well maintained areas for lessons / clubs
- Top level kit for school representative activities
- Break and lunch time equipment for children to be active

- 1. High participation level in curricular and extra-curricular PE and Sport
- 2. Co-ordinated approach to outstanding PE and Sports provision
- 3. Lifelong love of sport from participation, success and exposure to excellence
